



Parking Permits for Moving Day

What to know before you reserve street parking for your moving van.

When Do You Need a Parking Permit?

If your moving van will fit in a driveway or parking lot, you likely won't need anything special. But if you're moving to or from a residential property where street parking is limited and you expect to use public street space for loading or unloading, you may need a temporary parking permit or moving-related parking restriction. Permit names and application processes vary by city.

What to Know Before Moving Day

- ☐ Requirements vary by city — there's no single standard that applies across the Los Angeles area.
- ☐ Advance application may be required, and some cities require permits to be requested several business days before the move.
- ☐ Permit fees may apply, along with a separate charge for temporary "No Parking" signs in some cities.
- ☐ Temporary "No Parking" signs may be required, and some cities have specific rules for when and how they must be posted.
- ☐ Approval can depend on street conditions, traffic, nearby construction, and other local restrictions.

Requirements vary by city. Fees, notice periods, and application steps differ from one municipality to the next and can change over time. Always confirm current requirements directly with your city before moving day.

Where to Check Requirements

If you're moving in or out of one of these areas, check directly with the city's parking or public works department.

Don't Wait Until Moving Day

If your moving truck needs to occupy public street space, check your city's requirements as soon as your move date is confirmed. Some permits and temporary parking restrictions require advance notice, and last-minute applications may not be approved in time.

Quick Check: Before Moving Day

- ☐ Check your city's parking permit requirements.
- ☐ Confirm whether your address requires a permit.
- ☐ Check the application deadline and apply early.
- ☐ Arrange temporary "No Parking" signs if required.
- ☐ Confirm your truck can legally access and occupy the space.
